Parents & Guardians

The information below must be read and followed in order for Vacation care to run smoothly and the best quality care and be provided to your children.

Fees MUST be paid prior to care commencing.

Vacation care bookings will only be confirmed when fees are paid. The price per day is inclusive of all excursions/incursions, materials and nutritious afternoon teas. This cost is \$58.00 per child per day.

All children MUST wear a yellow T-Shirt on Excursions.

Wearing a yellow T-Shirt ensures all children are easily recognisable while in the public areas. This ensures their safety.

On a daily basis children MUST bring:-

- A hat, socks, closed in shoes
- Morning tea, drink bottle, lunch

(You may wish to purchase a sandwich, a drink and a piece of fruit from our cafe which will cost \$6.50).

- Children are not allowed to bring money as there will be no purchasing of goods on any excursions or at the Go Bananas Cafe.
- Breakfast will not be supplied in the mornings. Afternoon tea will be supplied.

Under NO CIRCUMSTANCES are there to be any **home toys** of any sort to be brought to Go Bananas.

(This includes mobile phones etc)

Children must be on their best behaviour while at Go Bananas, in travel for excursions and at designated excursions. Children who do not maintain their best behaviour may be excluded from excursions and if need be Go Bananas (as per health and safety to others and centre policies).
